ORDINANCE NO. 25

AN ORDINANCE REGULATING THE USE OF FIREARMS IN THE TOWN OF THOMSON.

THE TOWN OF THOMSON, CARLTON COUNTY, MINNESOTA, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section One - It shall be unlawful for any person to discharge a firearm for the purpose of "target practice" within the Town of Thomson within 500 feet of any building occupied by a human being or by livestock without first obtaining the written permission of the owner or occupant of the premises,

Section Two - Target practicing not prohibited by this Ordinance shall only be permitted when the line of fire of said individual is directed away from buildings occupied by human beings or livestock.

Section Three - Nothing contained herein shall affect the validity nor enforcement of Town of Thomson Ordinance No. 1 prohibiting the discharge of firearms in areas zoned R - residential nor M.S.A. 100.273 Trespass, relating to the taking of wild animals.

Section Four - Any person violating any provision of this Ordinance shall be guilty of a misdemeanor.

Section Five - This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and publication.
